1 What is your name?

2 How old are you?

3 Did you work in Canada? If so, are you receiving the **Canada Pension Plan (CPP)**? If no, do you want to apply?

4 Are you getting **Old Age Security (OAS)**? If so, how much are you receiving? If no, have you lived in Canada for at least ten years since turning 18? If so, do you want to apply? I would also apply for the **Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS)**. It takes an additional 5 minutes.

5 If people don't know they can phone **Service Canada**

6 Do you take the bus regularly? Are you receiving GIS? If so, do you want to apply for a \$45/yr bus pass?

7 Are you registered for **BC Med**? If no, let's apply.

8 Do you take prescription drugs? We don't need to know what they are. Do you pay the full price for these prescriptions? Do you have **Fair Pharmacare**?
